



IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT 2012 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS FOR TEAM COACHES AND MANAGERS

Here is some additional important information regarding the upcoming 2012 Karate Canada National Championships:

WEIGH INS

The procedure for weigh ins will be as follows:

There will be a sign up sheet available in the accreditation room on Wednesday, March 14th. Weigh ins will begin at 9:00 AM on Thursday, March 15th, and go until 3:00 PM to allow time to prepare for the Coaches' meeting.

On this sheet, there will be three one-hour slots in the morning, to be allocated to KBC, KQ and KO. As the Host province, KBC automatically receives the 9:00 AM slot. We will allow a half hour break at 12:00-12:30 to allow the volunteers a break and/or to catch up if some teams take longer.

The afternoon slots are all half an hour long. KAA will require their own half hour. The remaining teams may choose to come during whatever half hour slot they sign up for, but teams will be weighed in by group.

For the weigh ins:

All athletes **MUST** have their accreditation badge for weigh ins.

Teams are asked to arrive 15 minutes before their scheduled time.

To help speed up the process, teams are asked to be arranged in the following order: Junior Females; Junior Males; Senior Females; Senior Male (although 2 separate scales should be available for female and male athletes, thus speeding up the process).

For those athletes who may need to return, they may do so until 3:00 PM. If they cannot return by 3:00 PM, they must make arrangements for a time to be reweighed.

COMPETITION SCHEDULE
